

Indian Hills 5K Fun Run

The 2nd annual Indian Hills 5K Fun Run is fast approaching. You are invited to join this family-friendly event for runners and walkers on a road course through scenic Indian Hills.

The race, which will be held on July 4 at 8 am (registration at 7 am), will begin and end at Arrowhead Park. The southwest side of the route is shady and forested, with gentle slopes. Across Parmalee Gulch Road, the route is sunny and a bit steeper, with scenic overlooks of the entire mountain community.
