-Change in Medical Director. Dr. Tsipis has moved to Roanoke and Pat and I interviewed both his recommended replacement at Swedish Medical Center and we spoke with Common Spirit (formerly Centura) Pre-Hospital Services and elected to go with Common Spirit. -Generator-I still don't have the information from Xcel for getting the second bid on the generator. The bid we did get was explained more thoroughly and makes a lot of sense. With everything else, we would need a 32kw or larger generator, which would put us into a water cooled unit, which would put us over \$40,000. We could do a 26kw unit that would do everything we have now, plus all the furnaces with plenty of margin. That option is \$14k.
