

6/23/21 Chief's Report

- We've been given a new timeline of the week of July 12 for Engine 341 returning from the rebuild.
- Engine 342 has been working well in training over the last few weeks.
- Numerous departments in the area are deploying on the Sylvan Lake Fire and other large fires throughout the state. We are currently assessing what resources we have available in district and for deployment to see what resources we may be able to assist while retaining local response resources.
- The Jeffco Hazard Mitigation Plan is out for public comment.
- The MMWMC continues to be a good avenue for networking, cooperation, and support. The current focus is on commonality of mapping and looking at other counties with successful mitigation programs (Boulder, Douglas, Chaffee, etc.).
- AP Triton said they would have a draft by the end of the month, but mid-month made a large data request, so that seems unlikely at this stage.
- IH Mitigation group has decided to utilize the structure of IHIA for their 501c3 designation for moving the project of limited curbside chipping forward. Genesee's HOA has had a similar program for years and now the fire department is beginning to merge with the program to expand it to homes outside the HOA.
- 4th of July
 - Barricades and toilets set up
 - Jackie is continuing to organize the Pancake Breakfast
 - Plan to spread out between two bays rather than one.
 - Looking at outside serving rather than inside to reduce the risks around food.
