Resolution 2019-5 Indian Hills Fire Protection District

DESIGNATING THE REGULAR ELECTION TO HELD ON MAY 5th, 2020, APPOINTING A DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL, AND AUTHORIZING THE DESINGATED ELECTION OFFICIAL TO CANCEL THE ELECTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to 1-13.5-513, C.R.S., the Board of Directions of the Indian Hills Fire Protection District is authorized to designate an election official to exercise the statutory authority of the Board in conducting an election pursuant to the Colorado Local Government Election Code (Title 1, Article 13.5, C.R.S.); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 1-13.5-513, C.R.S., the Board of Directors can authorize the Designated Election Official to cancel the election upon certain conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE INDIAN HILLS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT THAT:

- The Board hereby names Sue Blair as Designated Election Official for the regular special district election scheduled for the 5th day of May, 2020; and
- 2. The Board hereby authorizes and directs the Designated Election Official to cancel said election and declare the candidates elected if at the close of business on the sixty third day before the election (May 5th, 2020) there are not more candidates for Director than offices to be filled, including candidates filling affidavits of intent to be write-in candidates, and no ballot issues or questions will be submitted to the voters.
- 3. The board further authorizes and directs the Designated Election Official to publish and post notice of the cancellation at each polling place and in the offices of the Designated Election Official, Clerk and Recorder of each county in which the District is located, and file the notice with the division of Local Government. In such event, the Designated Election Official shall also notify the candidates that the election was canceled and that they were deemed elected.
